Local workers among 800,000 nationwide are not getting paid during shutdown

What: Forty percent of the federal workforce – 800,000 employees nationwide – are not getting paid during the partial government shutdown that began at midnight Dec. 28. Bay Area members of the American Federation of Government Employees will protest at Oakland International Airport on Friday to highlight the impact the shutdown is having on workers, their families, and the nation.
